Her emotions were peaking as she walked through the doors, but she felt immediate relief when she was greeted by a smiling face. "Welcome to Toby's Place," the staff chimed. At this moment, Paula knew she would be ok.

Opened in 2017, Toby's Place serves an often-overlooked population of individuals experiencing homelessness: women and children. Equipped with a kitchen, private bedrooms, classrooms, a health clinic, play areas for children, and more, the facility is designed to meet the holistic needs of women and their children.

Toby's Place offers short-term shelter that provides up to 30 days of meals and shelter. The long-term program includes classes, counseling, and case management services, with job and housing placement as the goal.

Most importantly, Toby's Place offers a community for women who previously felt they had nowhere to turn. Through warm smiles, fresh meals, and spiritual encouragement, staff members want every guest who walks through their doors to feel like they're at home.

"When they welcomed me, I looked up and said, 'ok Lord, you're telling me now that this is where I'm supposed to be.' I just love what the Lord has done for me here," Paula said.
