ronetta entered the foster care system when she was 9 years old. Living in different homes and cultures taught her a lot about people and independence. However, she didn't have healthy ways to cope with the transitory lifestyle.

She started rebelling, which led to frequent suspensions at school. "I was going through the motions and didn't have self-awareness. I reacted to things out of anger," she says.

Sadly, Cronetta was unable to finish high school. She spent some time in the Job Corps and then college, but she didn't think she was ready for it. "I was still dealing with issues from when I was growing up," she shares. "I just wasn't focused."

She ended up getting pregnant and struggled to secure stable housing. She knew she needed more than just financial resources; she needed skills to live a stable life.

contacted us. When she arrived at Oliver Gospel, she was welcomed with a safe place to stay with her daughter. With all their basic needs met, she could focus on herself.

She loves the counseling that helps her address the root causes of her struggles. "The classes are awesome. I've learned to cope with my trauma," she shares. "Since coming to Oliver Gospel, I do not feel ashamed."

Cronetta now works as a restaurant manager. Our personal development classes have also helped her professionally. "I've been able to interact with people and understand them more."

Now, Cronetta is focusing on growing closer to God. "When I continue to keep Him in mind, read the Bible and let Him guide me, He will continue to protect me," she says.

Thank you for loving neighbors like Cronetta "as you've loved yourself." Your kindness has reminded her that she is not alone and that a better life is possible! "I'm thankful to Oliver Gospel for changing my life."
